Intro: G7 C (lastline of 1st verse)

(C) Rudolph, the red-nosed reindeer

Had a very shiny (G) nose,

And if you ever saw it,

(G7) You would even say it (C) glows.

(G7) Join in any reindeer (C) games. (C7) (*Pause here 2 beats*)

(F) Then one foggy (C) Christmas Eve,

(G) Santa came to (C) say,

(D) Won't you guide my (G7) sleigh tonight?"

(C) then all the reindeer loved him

And they shouted out with (G) glee,
